The students are continuing to do a lot of review in their handwriting group. Each group is working on specific needs.

In phonics, we are learning about the long and short vowels. This week was "Aa" and "Ii." They learned more about the "magic/silent e" that will go at the end of these words. They have some songs they like about this concept. Check out the "links" section for the videos.

We finished talking about 2D/3D shapes and positional words. We will move onto measurement next week.
