In math, we talked about patterns. The kids learned that a pattern repeats itself over and over. We learned to identify the "core" of the pattern as well. We talked briefly about how to name a pattern.

The focus for reading this week was colors, names, and beginning of the year stuff. We read a lot of books like Pete the Cat, Chrysanthemum, and The Squiggly Story. We learned our 3 new vocabulary words: idea, offer, stuck. .

We are continuing to review the school and classroom rules and expectations.
