The students learned about Mat Man. Ask them who he is and if they can sing the song to you!

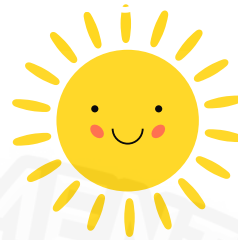
In phonics we went through the entire alphabet just to expose them. Now we will go back through and spend a more time on each one.
