WHAT DID WE DO THIS WEEK?

The students learned how to write upper and lower case Gg.

In phonics, we learned about LI and Hh. We reviewed rhyming and continued working on identifying the middle sound.

In SEL (Social Emotional Learning) learned about feeling worried and other feelings we might feel in our bodies.

We continued to learn more about addition and subtraction within 10. We focused on decomposing 5–10.

We continued with Module 4 in reading. We read the books: <u>Jack & the Hungry Giant</u> and <u>Edible Colors</u>. The vocabulary words were: serving, variety, and half.

In writing the students finished another story. This one was about decorating for Christmas or Thanksgiving.

In Social Studies we learned about Christmas around the world. We made "luggage" and "traveled" to Africa to learn about Kwanzaa, Israel for Hanukkah, and ended in Mexico for Las Posadas. We made artwork, learned about how each is celebrated, and read a book about each of the places. The kiddos loved it it! There are several videos on YouTube about all of the different ways Christmas is celebrated around the world. You can find links to the right of some good videos.
