WHAT DID WE DO THIS WEEK?

The students learned how to write upper and lower case Xx.

In phonics, we learned more about consonant blends. We also continued to learn about digraphs: th, sh, ch, wh. There are a lot of sight words this week. Please add them to your ring of words.

In SEL (Social Emotional Learning) learned about problem solving and trying to solve a problem on our own.

We learned about telling time. We started with learning the difference between a digital and analog clock. Then we learned about the parts of the clock and ended with telling time to the hour. They were excited to bring their clocks home to practice the time. They wanted me to share the songs we listened to this week. They are under the important links section.

We finished with Module 6 in reading. We read the books: Apple Pie, 4th of July and Happy Birthday to the U.S. The vocabulary words were: American, customer, and crowd.

In writing the students wrote stories across pages.

In science we learned about how plants change the environment. Ask your child to tell you one way plants are helpful to the environment.
