WHAT DID WE DO THIS WEEK?

For handwriting the students learned how to write upper and lower case Ll.

In phonics we learned about Zz. We have now all learned the letters of the alphabet. We will now move onto long and short vowels, double consonants, and digraphs.

In SEL (Social Emotional Learning) we learned about managing disappointment. I talked the kiddos about how sometimes things just don't work out the way they are planned and how this is a part of life.

We finished learning about teen numbers up to 19. We played some games and reviewed the numbers.

We started Module 6 in reading. We read the books: America the Beautiful and In Our Country. The vocabulary words were: America, country, right, plain, belong, and sea. Ask your child to show you the sign language for these words.

In writing the students are working on their own How-To. We did our cover page and the first 2 steps.

In science we discussed about the importance of dental health since it is Dental Health month. We read several books about going to the dentist, good and not so good food for your teeth, brushing, and many other things. There are many videos on YouTube about dental health.
