WHAT DID WE DO THIS WEEK?

The students learned how to write upper and lower case Aa.

In phonics, we learned more about the letters Gg and Kk. The sight words was: his. Please add this to your student's ring of words and continue to practice.

In SEL (Social Emotional Learning) we learned about doing something on accident or on purpose. If something was an accident we say, "I'm sorry, it was an accident." We talked about ways we could show empathy when something is an accident and has hurt someone.

In math, we continued learning about subtraction. The students really seem to be getting the concept well. We learned that subtraction is taking away from the whole number.

We started Module 4 in reading. This module focuses on health. We read the books: <u>Being Fit</u> and <u>Germs Are Not For</u> <u>Sharing</u>. The vocabulary words were: exercise, energy, healthy, active, stretch, and weight. Ask your child to show you the sign language for these words.

In Social Studies we learned about place in the neighborhood. We learned about street signs, addresses, roads, etc.
