The students learned how to write upper and lower case Dd.

In phonics, we took a little detour to learn about the long and short sounds of the letter Aa. The sight words were: am, at, go. Please add these to your student's ring of words and continue to practice.

In SEL (Social Emotional Learning) we learned about being assertive. We will continue to talk about this for weeks. Ask your child what being assertive means!

We continued to learn about the numbers 6-10. We learned how to compose the number 10 as well.

We continued Module 2 in reading. We read the books: <u>I Like Myself</u> and <u>ABC: I Like Me!</u> We made a list about things we like about ourselves. The vocabulary words were: bother, same, change.
