WHAT DID WE DO THIS WEEK?

The students were introduced to their handwriting book. They learned how to write upper and lowercase Ff. The new sight word was: I. Please add it to your ring of words.

In phonics, we are learned more about the letters Mm and Ss. We also learned about compound words. Ask your child to tell you a compound word!

The focus for math this week was comparing numbers 0-5. The students learned about equal, greater than and less than. They did really well grasping this concept.

We finished our first module in our reading curriculum. We read the books Schools Around the World and Annie Bea. We learned 3 new vocabulary words: city, country, map. I showed the students the classroom maps. They thought that was fun!

In social studies we talked about our timeline. We discussed the words; past, present, and future.

The students had guidance this week. They learned about the zones of regulation.

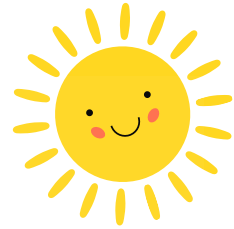
